ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981

- 2. THE A46 TRUNK ROAD (NEWARK TO WIDMERPOOL IMPROVEMENT AND SLIP ROADS) SUPPLEMENTARY (SIDE ROADS) ORDER NUMBER 1 20__**
- 3. THE A46 TRUNK ROAD (NEWARK TO WIDMERPOOL IMPROVEMENT AND SLIP ROADS) SUPPLEMENTARY COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER NUMBER 1 20__**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Public Local Inquiries will be held at Newark Town Hall, Market Place, Newark, Nottinghamshire NG24 1DU starting at 10am on Tuesday 8th November 2011 into the Secretary of State for Transport's proposal to make the Orders listed below, and into the objections which he has received in connection with that proposal.

THE INQUIRIES will be held by Robert Barker BEng (Hons) CEng MICE FIHT, a person appointed, on the nomination of the Planning Inspectorate, by the Secretary of State for Transport and the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government for the purpose of the inquiries into the Orders mentioned below.

THE ORDERS in question are:-

1. THE A46 TRUNK ROAD (NEWARK TO WIDMERPOOL IMPROVEMENT AND SLIP ROADS) MARGIDUNUM ROUNDABOUT (DETRUNKING) ORDER 20__ which was published in draft on 12th May 2011. This is an order under sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980 which, if made, would provide that a length of the Newark to Widmerpool Trunk Road (A46) at Margidunum Roundabout shall cease to be a trunk road and shall be classified as a principal road from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies Nottinghamshire County Council that the new trunk roads are open for traffic when this Order comes into force.



2. THE A46 TRUNK ROAD (NEWARK TO WIDMERPOOL IMPROVEMENT AND SLIP ROADS) SUPPLEMENTARY (SIDE ROADS) ORDER NUMBER 1 20_ _ , which was published in draft on 12th May 2011. This is an order under sections 12, 14, 125 and 326 of the Highways Act 1980 which, if made, would authorise the Secretary of State for Transport to stop up private means of access to premises and provide new means of access to premises in the vicinity of Farndon, Nottinghamshire;

3. THE A46 TRUNK ROAD (NEWARK TO WIDMERPOOL IMPROVEMENT AND SLIP ROADS) SUPPLEMENTARY COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER NUMBER 1 20_ _ which was published in draft on 12th May 2011. This is an order under sections 239, 240 and 246 of the Highways Act 1980, and under section 2 of the Acquisition of Land Act 1981 which, if made, would authorise the Secretary of State for Transport to purchase compulsorily the land and rights over land described in the Schedule to the Order for the purpose of:

- a) the construction of the new trunk road in The Parish of Farndon, in the District of Newark and Sherwood in the County of Nottinghamshire;
- b) the construction and improvement of highways and the provision of new means of access to premises in the parish and district in pursuance of the A46 Trunk Road (Newark To Widmerpool Improvement and Slip Roads) Supplementary (Side Roads) Order Number 1 20_ _;
- c) the improvement of the Trunk Road in the parish and district;
- d) the diversion of watercourses and the execution of other works on watercourses in connection with the construction of the new trunk road and the construction and improvement of other highways;
- e) use by the Secretary of State for Transport in connection with such construction and improvement of highways and the execution of other works mentioned above.

PROCEEDINGS on the draft Orders are being taken concurrently in accordance with section 257 of, and paragraph 20 in Schedule 1 to, the Highways Act 1980.

COPIES of the draft Orders and of the plans referred to in them have been deposited together with a copy of plans showing the land and may be seen at all reasonable hours free of charge, at the Highways Agency, The Cube, 199 Wharfside Street, Birmingham B1 1RN and at Newark Library, Beaumont Gardens Baldertongate Newark NG24 1UW.



THE INSPECTOR will hear representations from statutory objectors as defined in the Highways (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 1994 so far as concerns the Orders numbered 1 and 2 above, and remaining objectors, as defined in the Compulsory Purchase (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 2007 so far as concerns the Order numbered 3 above. He will also, at his discretion, hear representations from any other persons who may desire to appear and be heard.

OBJECTORS are reminded that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it; that it will be passed to the Inspector holding the inquiries; and that he may be required to disclose at the inquiries the objection or representation and, unless there are special reasons to the contrary, the identity of the author.
