Thames Gateway Bridge Enquiry

I wrote 2 letters of objection to the original enquiry . My principle objection was the inevitable increasing congestion the proposal would create . The mitigating factor TFL put forward was the toll system they would use to restrict traffic flows .

Since the end of the public consultation three new road issues not know of at the time have arisen

1] Proposed increase of tolls on the Dartford Crossing.


2 . Greenwich Council together with TFL considering a congestion charge for Greenwich which will include the Blackwall Tunnel (it was assumed that this would remain free by the inquiry)

3 . The impact that Crossrail will have on Abbey Wood if approved .

In addition to congestion we are also faced with the incinerator to be built in Belvedere which was not expected to be given approval at the time of the inquiry . The issue of air quality was a major concern and this is about to be made worse .

For all the above reasons I demand that the inquiry be reopened to allow current and future conditions to be investigated throughly !
