Appeal by Wind Prospect Developments Limited

Erection and operation of eighteen wind turbines with associated tracks, underground cables, switchgear building and anemometer mast at Green Rigg Fell, Birtley Parish, Tynedale.

The Town and Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) (England and Wales) Regulations 1999

I refer to the above appeal and a ruling that I made on 29 January 2008 at the continuing public inquiry into the above appeal. This letter is a formal request made under Regulation 19 of The Town and Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) (England and Wales) Regulations 1999 for 'further information' required for the purpose of the inquiry.

In this regard the company shall provide: -

- (i) a more detailed description of how the turbines might be connected to the grid (both as a stand-alone development and also in combination with Steadings and Ray wind farm proposals), including the methods proposed and any consequent effects entailed in traversing sensitive areas such as Hadrian's Wall World Heritage Site, supported by illustrative material, in so far as that is necessary: and
- (ii) a cumulative landscape assessment taking into account both the Amec Ray Estate and the Steadings wind farm proposals.
